



Tuition Assistance Program

Open to all Atlanta Fire Rescue Department Members

Member Eligibility:

- 1) have completed two years of continuous ARFD employment
- 2) is not under any disciplinary probation or suspension at application submission or dispersion of funds,
- 3) member agrees to 3 years continuous employment following dispersion of assistance, otherwise must reimburse AFRF for all tuition assistance,
- 4) is working toward a degree from a regionally accredited college or university; and.
- 5) maintains a 3.0 overall GPA and a 2.0 GPA for semester applied for semester seeking reimbursement.

How to Apply!

Application Deadlines – January 31, June 30, and September 30 for the preceding semester. Applications for the Tuition Assistance Program may be obtained from the Atlanta Fire Rescue Training Academy. Tuition Assistance – Approved applicants will be sent assistance checks for the preceding semester on March 1, August 1 and October 15th. **A maximum of \$1,800 per year per applicant** will be provided, and is based on number of applicants and total assistance pool amount requested.
